WHAT DO I NEED?

- Driver's license and social security number on hand
- Proof of ownership (or lease agreement)
- Street address (must be issued from your local municipality)
- A \$35 connect fee will be applied to your first bill.
- You may be asked to pay a deposit based upon credit check results (deposit amounts range from \$0 - \$275 and must be paid using cash, money order, debit or credit card prior to connecting service.

2 A DEMCO Representative

will meet with new member within 1-3 business days of the request to design the electrical layout for the new residential construction.

Contribution In Aid

- If applicable, contribution in aid must be paid prior to construction. This cost is provided to the member by the representative who designs the job.
- Payments can be made by phone or at any DEMCO district office using cash, money order, check, debit, or credit card.



4 Construction

A. Temporary Service

- Temporary meter pole and meter pan must be properly installed (see service specification handbook for details).
- Contact your local municipality to obtain the proper permits for temporary service (permitting office will notify DEMCO of approval).

B. Permanent Underground Service

- Contact DEMCO once your property is ready for permanent underground wiring (Please allow 7-14 days from the time of payment for installation of underground facilities).
- Service and meter pan must be installed to DEMCO specification (see service specification handbook for details).
- A DEMCO representative will visit the property to design the underground installation.
- Underground service must be installed prior to requesting permanent service.
- Contact DEMCO when you are ready to have the meter installed for permanent service.
- Contact your local municipality to obtain the proper permits for permanent service (permitting office will notify DEMCO of approval).

C. Permanent Overhead Service

- Contact DEMCO once your property is ready for permanent overhead service.
- Meter pan and weather head must be installed to DEMCO specification (see service specification handbook for details).
- A DEMCO representative will visit the property to design the overhead service installation.
- Contact your local municipality to obtain the proper permits for permanent service (permitting office will notify DEMCO of approval).
